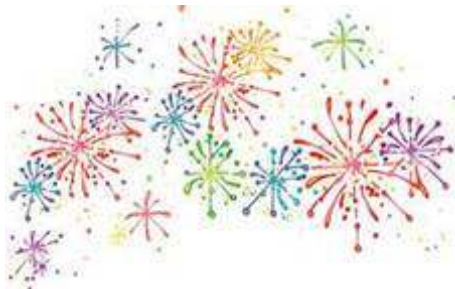

Pam and Jamie Martin: Silver Strike Pioneers

Sixteenth in a series of articles about club members who started collecting strikes in the early days and have contributed to the club's success.

"Pam and I started going to Las Vegas in 1998 on a company trip and we got hooked on Vegas, going back every 3 to 4 months. We became frequent players at the slot tournaments at Imperial Palace," says Jamie Martin. He and Pam live in Winter Garden, Florida.

Jamie vividly recalls one trip. "We were at Caesar's Palace. I was waiting for Pam to play this stupid souvenir machine that she was hooked on. I wanted to go back to the craps table and she was sitting with a roll of quarters playing a slot machine that didn't even pay money, just a souvenir coin. I put in a \$20 bill, hit 3 coins on the second pull, cashed out, gave Pam the coins and said, 'lets go,'" he said.

When they got home, Jamie had empty pockets and Pam had about twelve "coins" that she put in a box with about fifteen other "coins." "I didn't know she was already hooked," says Jamie.

The Imperial Palace gave them a quarter pound silver token as a gift for playing in their slot tournament on their next Vegas trip. "Pam got all excited and she showed me the strike machines at the Imperial Palace," Jamie recalled.

"The next day I showed the new quarter pounder to a woman playing the strike machine at the Las Vegas Club and asked her if she knew anything about them. The woman – "Carol" – said she would go get her husband if we would wait by the machine. He knew about them. Carol Heinz returned with her husband Gary (CHSS-0120) and for the next forty-five minutes to an hour we started a friendship that is still really hard to explain to this day. Needless to say, Jamie and I were hooked on strikes from that day on. He would have liked to collect them all, but I only care about the ones I win," says Pam.

Pam and Jamie met Carol and Gary at the O'Shea's World's First Silver Strike Tournament in December 2001 where they also met "a ton" of new silver striker friends. "One of them was a tall thin gentleman from Boston who can't pronounce automobile," says Pam with a smile.

Pam's interest in silver striking and the club evolved into her election in August 2005 as president of the Silver Striker Club. She served as president until August 2007. Since then she has written "Pam's Corner" in each issue of the club's newsletter to inform members about strikes, issues and events about silver striking and our club.

Jamie Martin has also contributed to the club's progress. He chaired the 2011 Club Coin Design Contest and he won the competition in 2010 for the new logo design on the club's limited edition silver strikes ("Welcome to the Fabulous Silver Strikers Club").

Some historic events from the year 1999:

The Silver Striker's Club began with 147 charter members. The first permanent officers were : President, Mary Lou Waterbury, First VP, Ray Moritz, second VP, Jack Haddock, Secretary, Rick Andrae, Treasurer, Evelyn D. Grosklaus. The club treasury at the time held a balance of \$1,267.55, \$1,420.08 was from dues and interest, and expenses totaled \$152.53. Of major importance at this time was to increase membership and get the word out that the new club existed. Plans were being made to hold a table at the next chip convention for providing information and the signing up of new members. According to the newsletter, there were 39 new Silver Strikes available in Las Vegas and Reno.

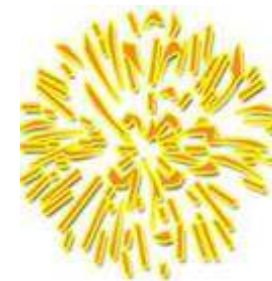
A bit of Las Vegas history:

While the Strip was booming, the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission on January 27, 1951 detonated the first of over a hundred atmospheric explosions at the Nevada Test Site. These atmospheric tests would continue until enactment of the Partial Test Ban Treaty in 1963 when the tests moved underground. The last test explosion was in

1992. Despite the dangers and risks, greatly under-estimated at the time, of radiation exposure from the fallout, Las Vegas advertised the explosions as another tourist attraction and offered *Atomic Cocktails* in *Sky Rooms* that offered a great view of the mushroom clouds.

CLUB DISPLAY FRAME UPDATE

The club had a chance this year to update our club display frame. It was decided to start a second frame due to the weight factor and not to make the first one look too congested. The first frame had the Artist name added to their winning coins for recognition of their achievements. When we started the second frame it was discovered that we did not have the first two coins needed to start it and a call went out for help. At first the two coins were loaned to the club by Jo Riefer so we could display them at the Club Forum and Meeting along with having them at our Convention Table. Hearing of our dilemma Charlie Keppner stepped up and donated the two coins needed from his personal collection. A VERY SPECIAL THANKS goes out the Charlie for his generosity.
