A bit about Coushatta Casino, opened in 1995, owned and operated by the Coushatta Indian Tribe, this casino features a 100,000 sq ft gaming floor, a luxurious hotel, RV resort, restaurants and live entertainment. It is located in Kinder, Louisiana which is in the southwestern part of the State approx. 30 mile north of the I10.



The games went live just a couple days after being delivered to the casino on June 17, 2020. Reports from club members that have attended and played them state that the machines were getting good play and paying well. 
