Message from the Editor

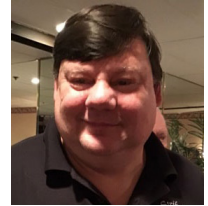

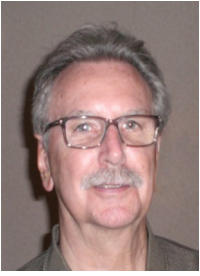

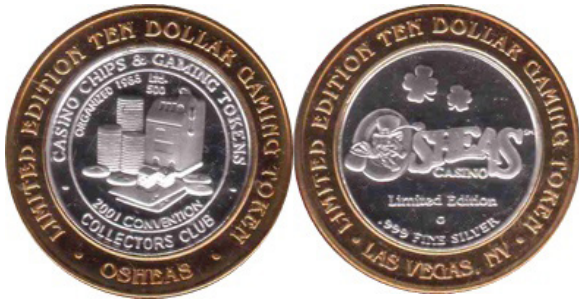

“COPPER” RIMS APPEAL TO “COLLECTORS”

On some of the casino orders in early 2001, the outside rims appear to be copper. This was caused by a processing problem with the supplier to Global Mint. Global decided to use the delivery though not the normal color. It has caused a stir among several collectors and some have brought nice premiums. Most are hard to come by at this point and have been replaced by the normal brass rims. If you know of one not listed, please let us know.

Silver Strike Memories

All of us have interesting collecting stories. My husband Alex and I travel all over, including Vegas once a year. We've been collecting Silver Strikes for 30 years and now own over 1,300. We LOVE our Silver Strikes! And over the years have had some adventures!

We were in the Bellagio early Thanksgiving morning (there were no other customers there) and our machine ran out of strikes. Because of the holiday, they were short-handed so we had to wait a while to be refilled. The slot boss came with a full rack but before loading the machine, took a strikeout of the rack and threw it in the tray as a thank-you for being patient.

I particularly like Luxor's Egyptian strikes so we kept playing the machine until we had all of them except King Tut's Mask. We played and played to no avail. We asked the slot attendant to slot the Mask in first when she refilled but she refused. The machine got hot and we REALLY started getting strikes, but no Mask. The slot attendant, I think, figured we were winning too much and wanted us to leave. She came over and asked "which one do you want?" and made sure to slot in Tut's Mask first. We got the Mask and left.

Another trip we found out to our delight that one Sahara machine gave refunds! Every time we put in 3 quarters, the machine gave us one back! And still spun! We picked up all the Genies that day!

And the day we got the Pink Las Vegas Sign in Slots-a-Fun was great! But the 3 Double Diamonds at Sam's Town giving us \$500 was better!! This \$500 win also happened at the Mirage.



The cage lady at Bill's Lake Tahoe, when we saw that they had taken out their machines, was nice enough to go into the safe and sell us (at face value) the ones we didn't have. As did the Comstock lady in Reno, who sold us all she had. (The 11 duplicates she sold us we are using to swap.) And the cage lady at Sierra Sid's in Sparks, when she saw that we had gotten a previous year's clear-capped Jake, said, "Oh, we are putting our old ones in red caps," and

swapped out the case. (But Janice O'Neal told me it was still considered a clear cap).

And the one that got away: while in Harrah's Laughlin, we saw the machine had already been emptied before removal and asked could we buy the 5 strikes on the top display, but were told no. Oh, well.

I was doing my daily walk in Reno and stopped into the Gambler on a whim. I put in 3 quarters and got all 3 different strikes ON MY FIRST spin!

We were coming back from dinner and noticed that the Silver Legacy strike machine was jammed. Alex went up to our room while I waited for a slot person to unjam it so I could play. The slot lady unjammed it and a silver strike fell out. She started to walk away and I told her that neither the strike was mine nor the 64 quarters left in the machine. She said "well, it's yours now" and left. Thank you, Silver Legacy!

But the best Reno story: we were in the airport and those days the machines had 3 lines of purple bars. A line of 3 single bars paid one strike, 3 double bars paid 2 strikes and 3 triple bars paid 3 strikes. Well, we got 3 double bars on one pay line and 3 triple bars on another, and FIVE strikes fell out! And 2 were blue caps, one "R" and one "N", finishing off our blue-capped "RENO" set! I screamed so loudly that Alex is permanently deaf in one ear!! (Just kidding)!



And one non-silver strike story: Alex was playing a Bally's machine which malfunctioned and all these quarters started dropping. The machine completely emptied and the tray was FULL. Alex (being the incredibly honest person he is) asked me to find a slot person so that he could return the money. The floor person who comes says "Oh, that's a runaway machine and in all my time here, I've seen only 3". She gets the boss who immediately tells Alex "that's not your money, it belongs to the casino". "I know", Alex says and waits for the boss to tell him to give it back. Well, I guess the boss felt bad and wouldn't actually do that so they dance around a little with the boss repeating that it isn't Alex's money. Finally, the boss asks Alex how much he had in the machine and Alex says "about \$20". So, the boss picks up one of the big plastic cups and asks "if I filled this up, would you get your money back?" Alex agrees and we take the full cup to the cage. \$175!! There must have been over \$1,000 in that tray.

The people we've met have just been so generous. The guy at the Fitzgerald's machine who gave me a strike we didn't have. (I passed that on by giving Leroy from Hawaii one HE didn't have). Richard Anderson (writer of the original Silver Strike catalogs) whom we saw in the Palms gave us an empty brand-new red cap case (out of his attaché case full of them) when I told him one of ours was cracked. Charlie Keppner who, when we were all standing in line at Sam's Town to swap our \$10's for the \$200, made sure we all had ours before he swapped for a second one. And of course, Janice, whom we originally met at the Gamblers Store, and Jerry O'Neal who started us on our quest by generously sharing so much information. (Although I will say, that when we were over their house and saw that she had 3 full sets of the 4 Queens blue-capped Kings, I was a little envious! We still don't have any of them.)

Finally, a big THANK YOU to Shaun Webster at the Four Queens, who for many years has single-handedly kept the hobby alive with new strikes. Keep 'em coming, Shaun, we appreciate you!

We belong to the Silver Strikers Club and I encourage everybody to join. We have a Players' Tournament every year plus we piggyback onto the Casino Collectibles Convention. Our website is silverstrikers.com. The nicest people plus beautiful Silver Strikes!

THE SILVER STRIKE “MULE”

If you know much about how a “mule” is created, you know it has to do with a horse and a donkey getting together. Hence, neither a horse nor a donkey has been created, but instead you have a mule. Oh well, let’s consider a silver strike. A “mule” in this case is the result of an unanticipated matching of dies that were NOT meant to be paired. Example: Mr. B’s where two reverses were mated to make a “mule.” All “mules” in the silver strike world are rare and desirable.

Others include:

- The CLASSIC!** Gold River, Laughlin mixed with Isle of Capri, (Biloxi, MS) (each casino is pictured on their respective side)
- Fremont Hotel /Sam’s Town Casino (3 designs)
- 98-99 Don Laughlin (“LM” mint with “G” mint)
- Gold Country (Pony Express & Train “G” mint instead of “LM”)
- Reno Flamingo Tiger (.999 on rim instead of silver center)
- San Remo Roll into the Millennium (.999 on rim instead of silver center)
- Eldorado, Reno (building with bridge (GDC design) – small logo “G” mint)
- Pioneer, Laughlin (6 designs where millennium logo should have been used)
