LOST ATLANTIS-LOGO

Once again a casino has issued a strike without the correct logo. We saw this not too long ago with the Eldorado and it happened with the Millennium issue from the Pioneer in Laughlin. This time ATLANTIS HAS RISEN with a rare logo error. The Toucan and Angel Fish Strike was originally issued with the old hotel logo. Recently it has been discovered that there was one minting with the new hotel logo, which was designed for the Skyway 1999 Grand Opening. This is indeed an error and at this writing we know of only 6. Not very likely some of you collectors have one or perhaps two in your collection and what a find that would be. The timing is unsure of for this error, however, it has been listed twice on eBay, once not meeting the \$1,500 reserve that was placed by the seller and the second time purchased by the author for \$356.00. There were few bidders at the time as information has not previously been mentioned on any message boards or newsletters, but there was one at the Convention so some collectors knew about the strike. Below is the scan of the Strike, the correct logo, and lastly, the error logo. This may well become one of the rarer of the error logo strikes so check your collections carefully. We do know from various collectors that there are none left in the vaults of the casino and that they have "walked" or flown the coop. Good luck on your hunt for the LOST ATLANTIS. MIDWEST REPORT

Good news for anyone that didn't make it to the convention in Las Vegas. There is going to be a "Chippers Weekend" at Harrah's Casino, Tunica, MS. The dates are October 26th & 27th. The hours are 12:00 to 6:30 p.m. Friday and 10:00 to 4:30 p.m. Saturday. For dealer information contact Jim Kruse at 816.420.8590. Jim has also arranged for special room rates at Harrah's. For reservations call 662.363.7777, ask for code S102601.

During July, Harrah's, Kansas City, opened a 2nd floor to their land based casino. On August 3rd they moved the riverboat from here to Players Island, Metropolis, IL. to replace a smaller boat. The old Sam's Town, Kansas City riverboat was moved to Players Island, Lake Charles, LA. Harrah's had purchased Sam's Town about 2 years ago and has

since sold the property. Harrah's has also purchased Harvey's Casino in Council Bluffs, IA. The Isle of Capri has purchased the Flamingo in Kansas City and will open a new casino around the first of the year in Booneville, MO. Ameristar has purchased Station Casinos in Kansas City and St. Louis. The owner of the St. Joe Frontier has opened a 2nd casino in northeast Missouri.

In the Midwest these days there are not many casinos that still dispense silver strikes. Currently no strikes are being issued in Missouri, Louisiana, Wisconsin and North Dakota. Strikes are still available at Prairie Meadow Racetrack, Iowa, Firefly Creek, Minnesota, Traverse Bay, Michigan, Victories, Michigan, Chip-In, Michigan, Sam's Town, Mississippi and Canyon Club, Colorado. Interest in these mid west strikes seems to be increasing as prices on current auctions in some cases have sold in the \$60 plus range.
