

PRESIDENT'S REMARKS

We spent a few days on the Strip (since that casino no longer has strikes, I do not feel the need to list them) and one day we went over to New York New York. I had heard that these were quite hard to get but luck was with me as I got seven strikes for my first \$20 with quarters left over! We next stayed overnight at the Las Vegas Club and were able to pick up several of the first five Olympic strikes. Freddie Maatouk, Director of Slot Operations was very gracious to us and treated us royally.

By previous arrangement Ralph Bjornson and Bill Brooks who had come to Vegas came by and took us out to the Palms. It was the first time Clayton and I had been there and we all immediately started taking turns playing the two strike machines. Bill does not quite understand how Ralph and I were able to get our 20+ so easily and so inexpensively. Just lucky Bill! We were working to get that new \$200 that was to come out in just a few days. This \$200 used a design that Bill had shown the slot manager and we got to see the prototype. It is simply beautiful and will go so well with the 9-11 strikes.

From the Palms we went to the Suncoast-another casino which was also a first time for Clayton and me. Again, I was able to get the new set except for the Towers but I was able to trade.

Clayton and I were going to Hemet, CA and did not want to haul all our strikes with us so we gave that suitcase to Ralph. In it were the 20 \$10 Palms strikes, which he and Bill were to trade in for us for the \$200. After Hemet we went down to San Diego to spend a few days with Ralph and Donna Bjornson. It was Doug Conley's turn to set up the trading session for the Southern California group. What a thrill it was to drive up and see Doug Conley. We hopped out of the car and there was Tom Hollywood. It is always special when he is there as he keeps things lively! Also attending were Dave Ruffel, Sue and Bill Cohenour, Gary Heinz, Bill Brooks, Pam Corry, Frenchy Choquette (he had to behave, he sat by me), Richard Dickenson, Jim Quinn and Norm Chrzanowski. Also, Doug's wife Nancy came by for a few minutes. We all thought it was a very good trading session and it was quite brisk for awhile. We also had breakfast together-but food was not the most important thing.

FORTUNE BAY PATRIOTIC STRIKES

At the beginning of the year, Dennis Finn posted that the Fortune Bay Casino had a new set of patriotic strikes delivered to them. I spoke via emails and by phone with the Casino Manager, Mr. Terry Sandnas about when they might begin putting them into the hopper. Towards the end of January, my brother Brain and I made the 9-hour trek up to Fortune Bay, which is in Tower, MN. It's a very nice Native American casino in the "northwoods" of Minnesota, up near the Canadian border. Their new set consists of 5 different designs. It is a great looking set with a couple of new designs not seen on any of the Nevada patriotic issues. The casino has named the collection "America Will Not Forget-A Tribute to America's Heroes". According to Mr. Sandas, the Casino only minted 50 sets of these strikes. He said they are only putting a few of the new ones into each hopper fill. This could make this set very hard to come by I did manage to get a couple of sets after playing through a couple hoppers.

Mr. Sandnas and everyone at the Casino was very friendly and helpful, which made our trip that much more enjoyable. On my next trip back I hope to take a picture of their Silver Strike Machine as it is a different kind than we are used to playing. It is a video reel type of slot machine and has a few different kinds of credit pays. I would like to thank Mr. Sandnas for the time he spent speaking with me about the history of

their silver strikes. I would also like to thank Fortune Bay Resort Casino for putting a new set of strikes into play, which does not happen often, if at all, here in the Midwest. In case anyone is wondering, it was -17 up there when we went. The things we go through to get Silver Strikers.

DID YOU HEAR?

Howdy's Illustrated Guide to Nevada Silver Strikes, 2nd edition, is to be issued by April 1, 2003.

IGT has removed the "hockey puck" strike delivery concept from the new silver strike machine.

There have been two casinos that have requested permission to use the Silver Strike logo on silver strikes to be issued at convention time.

New gaming regulations require that the minimum number of any "stated limited editions" of tokens (strikes) be 500. There may be a couple of exceptions to this do to approval timing, but from here on, no less than "500" to be stated on any strike.

Palms Casino is working on artwork for 4-\$10 strikes with Seattle Slew on them. They celebrate The Triple Crown, Kentucky Derby Belmont Stakes and The Preekness. There is to be a \$200 strike for this series.

(Not to be confused with the CHIP auction of CC>CC)

CUT OFF IS APRIL 1, 2003

Each Silver Striker member is entitled to submit four (4) silver strikes for the Club's auction held on Thursday night at the convention. Some great strikes have found new homes via this auction and some decent prices have been paid. We ask that the strikes are at least somewhat rare and carry a premium. THE COST OF A NUGGET ROOSTER STRIKE

There are two strike machines at the Sparks Nugget – one dispenses the Golden Rooster silver strike and the other the Restaurante Orozko. The Orozko machine is the old "bars pay" type and does not accept the Nugget Club Card for points. A point or \$1 is added for each \$100 you play which can be used in the casino restraints, etc. However, the Rooster machine does accept the card, as it is the more common machine that pays with "three 7's."

Now here's the real info. I got my card in Dec. just before playing for the silver strikes to obtain the \$200 one-pounders. I used the card only on the rooster silver strike machine, as that is the only machine I play. I requested a statement for taxes on my account and here it is:

Coin in \$1,738

Coin Out \$830 (83 strikes)

That's \$20.90 each

Here's the "REST OF THE STORY." The "coin in" is misleading because it includes the pays from cherries and bars, which go into credits that are played to achieve the silver strike jackpot. The records I kept indicated that each rooster strike during December cost \$17.60. Not a particular bargain. Another statistic is that it takes one hour to play \$300, which as you can see didn't produce 20 strikes, at least during December.

CHARGING FOR POSTAGE

There is always a lot of discussion on the subject of how much to charge, or be charged, for postage and handling on silver strike auctions. Certainly, know the cost before you bid and figure that cost into the amount you are willing to pay for the strike. The Silver Strike Chapter encourages a reasonable charge for postage. Make your money from the sale of the strike! – NOT postage and handling.

An actual postage cost breakdown would be:

One strike in bubble pack:	\$.60
One strike in bubble pack insured for \$50	\$1.90
One strike in bubble pack insured for \$100	\$2.80

A small bubble pack should cost about 50 cents to \$1.00. Now, if there is a charge for standing in line at the post office – GOOD LUCK!

ARTICLES WANTED!!

In order for this newsletter to remain interesting and broad in scope, YOU are requested to participate by sending articles – short or long – to be included here. Many of you have had interesting experiences while chasing silver strikes that would be great to share and others of you know something about silver strikes you've never seen any information on.

Here's a story, as an example, told by Peter Van der Kar back in 2000:

We have all heard the old adage, "which comes first, the chicken or the egg?" In silver striking there also is an adage, "which comes first, ONE MORE TWENTY or THIS IS MY LAST TWENTY". Lloyd Malani was grappling with this issue at Harrah's, Las Vegas, not long before they took out the \$40 machines and after two twenties and one strike he said, "this is my last twenty". Unfortunately he did not line up any bars. Sixty dollars for one \$40 strike was enough. As he began to walk away he changed his mind, turned around and said, "one more twenty". Does this answer the question? Well, I think it is different for each of us. Anyway, a few pulls later he lined up the triple bars on the bottom row and was really excited when his three strikes dropped out followed by a fourth. Looking up he noticed that the single bars had lined up on the top line. Four \$40 strikes for his "one more twenty". Well, JACKPOT!!

He was so excited that he didn't even care that there were three duplicate Sax Players and Bourbon Street. He had now a total of five \$40 strikes for eighty dollars. Back in his hotel room, after a long day of striking, he began to look at his loot. Surprise, surprise. The three Sax Players were all different logos; alligator no-date, alligator 1995, and the stars logo. These three plus a Bourbon Street and Construction Zone gave him five new strikes for his collection with no duplicates. What a windfall, and based on what these older strikes are going for he had really won a significant JACKPOT. So next time you put in your LAST TWENTY, remember what ONE MORE TWENTY can do and good luck to everybody!
