PRESIDENT'S REMARKS

Greetings to all my fellow Silver Strikers. As I arrived home in Houston fresh from the convention I could not help but to think about all of the friends I talked to and the fun I had just had in Las Vegas. All of the sights, sounds and silver strikes from Las Vegas are fresh in my mind. As a silver strike collector this has to be the highlight of the year. I know it is for me. It is hard to believe that four years ago we started with sixty people and we are now approaching the six hundred member mark and we are still growing.

The first Silver Strikers event was on Tuesday at the El Cortez. We had over one hundred people in attendance at our official Silver Strikers Chapter trade session. We had guests from the Sunshine Mint and IGT on hand to talk about the strikes that would be in play shortly. Everyone had a great time and lots of trading was done. As soon as the trade session was over the action began on the silver strike machines. Everyone was allowed to win the new set of three \$10's, five Silver Strikers logos strikes and twenty extras to trade in for the new \$200. The action continued across town at the Palms with the two new Club and Chapter logo strikes, three new \$10's and a \$200. Wednesday morning the fun continued on Fremont Street at the Plaza with two new \$200's, ten new \$10's and one CC>CC logo strike. At the Las Vegas Club they added the last five \$10's of their winter sports series and our Silver Strikers logo strike to the mix. And let's not forget the Four Queens. They took delivery of the remaining \$200's and had them available for us. They had a waiting list for their strike machine and were checking ID's to make sure each person only played one hopper fill. New strikes were also in play at Bally's and New York New York. It sure is great to have IGT and all of these casinos putting out strikes for us to collect.

Now on to the CC & GTCC Convention. The festivities began on Wednesday with the banquet and trade session. The event was sold out and every table was full. It was well attended by Silver Strikers and trades were made by all. Thursday was our day for events. The Silver Strikers Forum was first with guest speakers Gene Trimble from the Palms Casino Resort and Howard Herz of Gaming Archaeology. I thank these gentlemen for addressing our group. IGT and the Palms Casino Resort gave everyone in attendance a special limited NCV strike. Thanks to Don Hallmark, Director of Slot Operations, Palms Casino Resort and to Donna Killman, Silver Strike Program Coordinator, IGT. Later in the day we had our annual Silver Strikers Business Meeting, New Officer

Installation and our Annual Silver Strike Auction. Each out going Officer was presented with a plaque thanking them for their years of service to the Chapter. On each plaque was a 2003 blue capsule Silver Strikers logo strike from the El Cortez Casino. Thanks goes to Rick Ronca, Corporate Slot Director, Exber, Inc. for donating the five strikes needed for the plaques. I also would like to thank Freddy Maatouk, Las Vegas Club and Jack Budde, Plaza Hotel for their hospitality. After the plaques were presented the auction began, conducted by Jack Haddock. We had 32 lots up for sale. Several nice strikes were auctioned off raising much needed funding for the Chapter. On Friday and Saturday I got to visit with all of the silver strikers in attendance and with the dealers. Everyone said this year was better than last and I would have to agree. I have to say that the outgoing Officers have done a great job on this year's convention and I hope we can do the same in the years to come. I also need to mention the Chapter Table. We had a nice turnout of volunteers to man the table. Thanks to each and every one of you for your help. Job well done. I am already working on plans for the 2004 Convention. It will be held at the Riviera Hotel and Casino in June. It is not too early to start making plans. See you all then.

He was cornered at the Florida Silver Strikers Trade session and right away he was on board with the idea. Initially he was thinking it would be for a Florida Website only, then he was told, "NO! NO! Think bigger" this is for the Silver Strikers Chapter. We want a national Website, the biggest and the best. Please know that at that moment Jim Moser, our new Webmaster, came along. The Nevada casinos, which still have strikes in play and those that allow you to purchase strikes are also listed for your convenience. Remember, this again is an ever-changing area and this information is only as good as the information supplied.

El Cortez-Las Vegas put 3 new patriotic \$10 strikes in play, Mt. Rushmore, Eagle and Statue of Liberty and 1 new \$200 Eagle/Flag strike.

Plaza-Las Vegas has issued the 7 \$10 Hawaiian Island strikes along with 3 others, Mt. Rushmore, Abe Lincoln and the Spirit of Freedom. Two new \$200 strikes, the Twin Towers and Waterfall Hawaiian Islands are also in play.

Las Vegas Club-Las Vegas has issued the last 5 of their Winter Events series, freestyle skiing, short track skating, Nordic combined, curling and skeleton.

Palms-Las Vegas released 3 new automobile-themed \$10 strikes, 1953 Corvette; 1964 Corvette and 1966 Mustang and 1 new \$200 strike, Welcome to Las Vegas sign. They are also planning to release 5 new \$10 strikes honoring the branches of the U.S. military and 1 new \$200 strike, Defenders of Freedom.

New York New York-Las Vegas issued 3 new sports series and 3 new 6th Anniversary strikes and has 5 new Babe Ruth strikes to issue.

Silver Legacy-Reno will celebrate their 8th birthday on July 28th with another anniversary strike.
