

## THE YEAR WAS 2001

2001 was a busy year for Mary Lou and her team. There was outstanding membership growth, strikes being issued, convention, September 11th and the first Silver Strike Tournament.

How strikes were advertised was a hot topic in 2001. RARE – SCARCE – WOW – LQQK - HTF – RARE. Peter Van der Kar, editor of the Silver Strikers Newsletter, had this to say; "I would significantly add the word "RARE" is an anagram for "REAR", so next time you post one of your treasures try not to make a "REAR" of yourself when describing a strike that is "RARE"."

There was lots of activity on new strikes, with Caesar's Palace finishing up artwork for a \$5.00 Silver Strike Machine, where one can win a highly prized \$200 face/ 1 pound of silver.

In 2001, the Reno Hilton was issuing a different strike each month.

The March newsletter listed some Ebay results for various denomination strikes ranging from \$750 (\$10 Flamingo, Reno, NO WORD BOWLER) to \$135.00 (\$40 Nevada Landing, Jean).

Chapter Polo shirts went on sale.

It's the end of May and Silver Strike Chapter members of the CC&GTCC, are on their way to the convention, at the Tropicana. Another reason to be in Vegas at this time was to get a Silver Strike with the chapter's logo on it. The Union Plaza had two silver strikes: one in honor of the Silver Strike Chapter and the other recognized the CC&GTCC. The strikes went in play on opening night of the convention. Attendees also had the opportunity to hear two great speakers, thanks to Dennis Finn. Tom Power, Production Manager, Sunshine Mint and Rick Ronca, Slot Manager for the Union Plaza.

Copper rims appeared on some strikes this year. This was caused by a processing problem at the Global Mint. Global decided to go ahead with the delivery, although not its normal color. This caused quite a stir among collectors and some of these strikes have brought a nice premium.

December found O'Sheas Casino holding the first Silver Strike tournament. There would be 150 entrants, at a cost of \$300.00 each. The tournament was a great success and the participants had a good time and were treated royally.

### Latest Strike Machine Update By Jeff Bitzer

They have one \$10 machine and two \$40 machines. There is five \$10 strikes of Native American designs and five Semi Truck tractor designs. Mintage not known for initial run.

**Red Rock Casino** strikes are approved and in production at the mint. They should be in place an ready sometime this month. Possible designs are of Golden Knights hockey team and/or Aviator Minor League Baseball.

*Plaza Casino* have four new designs in the works to be completed by years end or the first of the new year.
