Hello Fellow Silver Strikers

June's Summer Tournament was a great success for the Clubs fundraising efforts. On Saturday June 24th throughout the day, we sold shirts, Club coins, and raffle tickets to raise money for the Club. That evening we had our Ice Cream and Cookie social. We sold raffle tickets up until it was time for the drawings. We had two different raffles, a 50/25/25 cash raffle, and a prize raffle. For the prize raffle the Club purchased several Silver Strikes for prizes. We also held an auction with items donated by fellow Club members. On behalf of the Silver Strikers Club, I would like to thank the Club Members who donated items to the raffle and Auction. Making it one of our best yet!

If you have a Silver Strike or other item, you would like to donate to the Club for a future fundraising event please let one of the Board members know. It saves the Club money on purchasing prizes.

Now for the Numbers:

Shirt Sales, we sold 7 Polo, and 28 T-shirts (which may be a record) raising \$595.

Club Coin Sales, we sold 27 Club coins from this year and one from last year raising \$975.

Cash Raffle 50/25/25, The Club sold 846 tickets for this raffle. Generating \$424 for the Club and two Club members winning \$211 each.

Prize Raffle, we raffled off some awesome Silver Strikes and ended up selling \$1179 in tickets.

Auction, there were a lot of great items donated by Club members that raised a grand total of \$1220 (which also might be a record).

We also received cash donations totaling \$80 thanks to Mary Lou Waterbury putting her initials on a few Club Coins we sold. Thank You Mary Lou.

All in all, the Club grossed a whopping \$4473.

These events were a huge success for the Club, and I am looking forward to doing it again in January 2024.

There was 139 votes cast for the SOTY and 135 votes cast for HOF

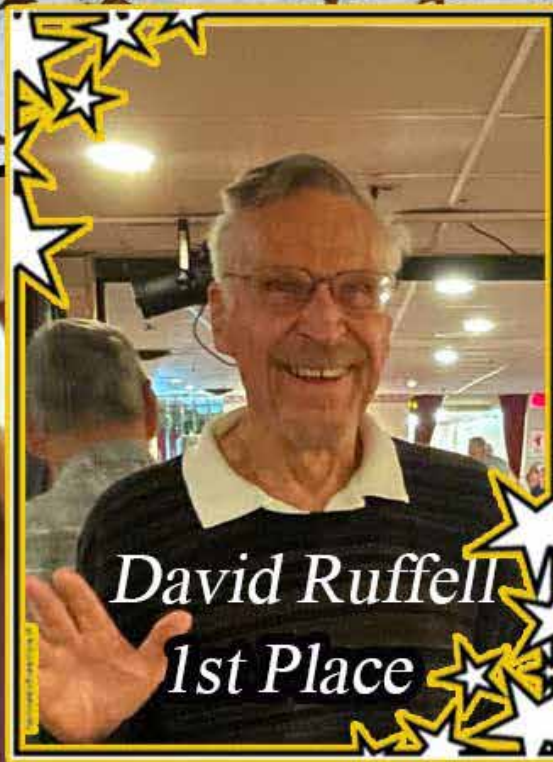


Hello Everyone.

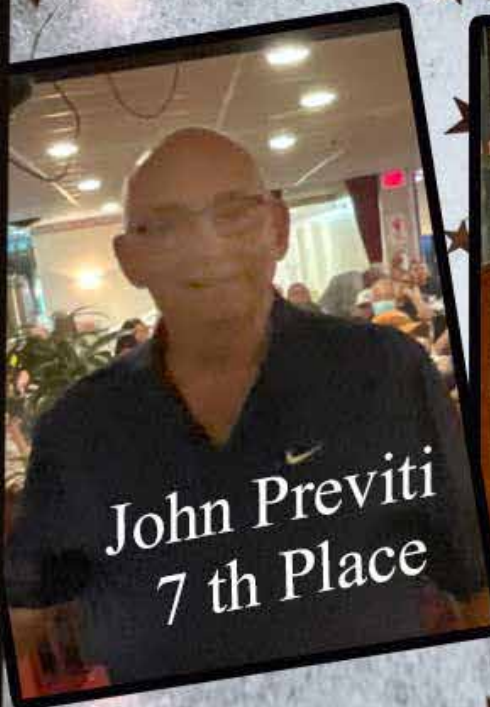

Silver Strikes on The Chip Guide

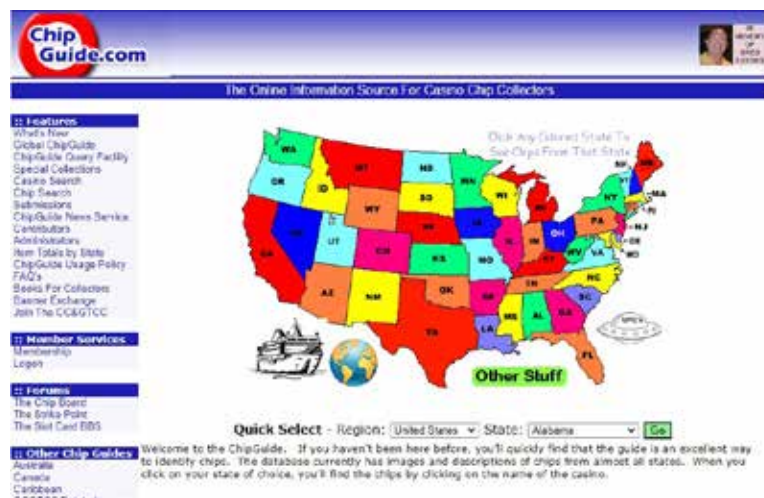
Alot of Silver Striker Club members are also members of the Casino Collectibles Association and will know about the Chip Guide, but there are many new members that may not know about it. There are alot of new features that current CCA members may not know about. So in this issue, I am going to take our members through the Chip Guide and how it ties in with the Silver Strikes.

Lets start with the mission statement:

The Greg Susong Digital Media Center is dedicated to Casino Chip and Gaming Token Collectors Club Hall of Fame member Greg Susong. Greg is one of those who brought the Internet to chip and token collecting. His website, The ChipGuide, was one of the first sites devoted entirely to chip and token collecting, and serves as a tremendous resource for collectors throughout the world. His work has been kindly donated to the Museum and will be continued to be updated here.

You may think the Chip Guide is all about casino chips, far from it, the Chip Guide is for all casino collectibles including Silver Strikes. It has taken some time for our strikes to get listed but back a few years ago Al Scalzo, Webmaster Assistant added all the Silver Strikes to the Chip Guide that he was aware of. Some images were added at the time but mostly added basic descriptions. Over the next few years alot people submitted images and updated info to fill in the blanks. Fast forward to a couple years ago, I decided it was time to get the Chip Guide and Silver Striker websites to match each other on information and images. As a Chip Guide administrator, I was able to take on this task on. I have been working with our Membership chairman, Allan Childers on getting alot of this information correct and in the correct order. The largest area was the Four Queens Casino, with 351 strikes and counting. Recently another major change took place. Up till a few weeks ago, there was only one type casino collectible listing for Silver Strikes which was Silver Strikes. I felt that the Tournament strikes and Club Coins do not meet the actual definition of a Silver Strike and should have their own collectible types. I started a conversation with Webmaster Charles Kaplan on adding these two new types. After much discussion, we came up with the new type "Silver Strike - No Cash Value". I decided to list all the Tournament Strikes under this type. I also created our club as a Casino Club under the Nevada casino listings. So our Tournament Strikes are listed under both the casino that the tournament was held at and under our stand alone club listing. Not to forget about our Club Coins, I chose to list them under the Silver Striker Club as they have no ties to any casino and they fall under the "Tokens - Other" type. Lets get to some screen shots to show what I just talked about.

This screen may look identical to the last one but there is one small difference. This is the same screen but I have logged in to the site this time.

Take note of 3 red circles beside the CG number. This is the key to what the Chip Guide can offer to help catalogue your collection.



Let's talk about these 3 red circles and what they mean. The first circle or button MC stands for **My Collection**, WL stands for **Want List** and the last one TL stands for **Trade List**.



Note in the next pic above the MC button is Green now. The difference is I clicked on the Red MC button and the screen refreshed and the button turned Green. So what does this mean for you. Well if you have one of the printed catalogues, it allows you to check off a box with a pen or pencil that you now have that particular strike in your collection. Clicking the button to make it Green is the same thing. Instead of carrying your catalogues around at a show or store, you can just use your cell phone, tablet or laptop to look up to see if you have a particular strike. The next button, the WL-Want List is another way mark off a particular strike you may be looking for. TL-Trade List button is a way to mark that you have an extra strike to sell or trade. At this point you may be reading this and think if I don't click on the MC button then it obvious that I need that particular strike so why would I need to click on the WL button. There is a reason for this which is what I will cover next.

Let's assume you went through your strike collection and clicked on all the MC buttons and now you want see what you own. The next few slides will take us through this procedure.



We are going back to the beginning now, the login screen. Once logged, you will see your name in Yellow on the black tool bar. For the purpose of what we are learning here we proceed to click on Search and then ChipGuide Query

Once you click on the CG Query Facility as noted above, this is the screen that will show up, all ready for you to fill in the necessary fields that will bring up the items we are looking for.



I filled in the following fields, Region (United States), State (Nevada), Collectible Type (Silver Strikes) and it brings back 56 pages of Silver Strikes with a total found of 2800. So this tells us there are 2800 silver strikes listed in the State of Nevada of all denominations as I left that field blank. You can they are listed in order of denomination first then alphabetical by casino name


In this screenshot, the only thing I changed was to change the Denomination field to \$10. So this is now showing us that there is 48 pages of strikes for a total of 2367 Silver Strike Listings. This is where I am trying to make sure every Silver Strike listed on our website is also listed on here.




If you are a member of CCA or MoGH you will also see the red buttons as I mentioned earlier.

Just a note here on this last screen, if you click on an individual picture it will open up a new window with a slightly enlarged picture. At this point also you can narrow it down to \$7 strikes if that is what you want to search for or \$40 strikes. You can change the State from Nevada to Colorado if you only want to see the Colorado strikes. Note if you really want to narrow down a search, you can search by city. So if you pick Las Vegas from the City dropdown menu, it will only show you strikes from Las Vegas. Next up I am going to show you what comes up when you click on the CG number under the image.

So from that last screen, i just clicked on the CG178874 that just under the 4 Red buttons. This is what will come up next. Here it shows us all the information on that strike along with an image of both sides of the strike. It also gives you all the information on the casino in the top half of the screen.

The strike information is usually from the person who submitted the strike image on the submission page or in my case, when I am listing or checking them, I take the information from the Silver Striker catalogue web page. This is where I am trying to make sure all the information from both sources all lines up. Sometimes I find info that I send to Silver Striker webmaster Jim for him to change.

If you are on the Chip Guide and see info that needs to added or an error, let me know. Allan Childers has been working with me on this and going through filling in the images and advising me of any errors. If you see an image that is blurry or not very good, you can send me new and better scans/photos if you have them. I have been using alot of images from the Silver Striker website and have permission in case your wondering from anyones submissions on the Silver Striker website.

Lets review up to this point, anyone from the public can see all the items on the Chip Guide and can use the search function as I have shown above.

Next for those that are members of the CCA or MoGH or anyone that may want to join these clubs for the added benefits, I will show you how you can keep track of what you have on here.

If we go back to the main search screen, under the Keyword field you will see it says List with a drop down menu. This list has the names of everyone that is using these features. So you can see I clicked on Robb McPherson - Collection. Now when I hit the Green Query button, it brings up every item that I have marked the little red button which turns green when I do that to show up here. You can see under each listing image the little green MC button is lit up. Right now it shows i have 52 items marked as in my collection.
