<u>A Brief History</u>

 The Silver Strikers Club was formed in 1999 by 140 collectors as a chapter of the Casino Chip and Gaming Token Collectors Club (CC>CC), now known as the Casino Collectors Association (CCA). The original 140 members are known as "Charter Members".



- In 2004, the Club became a stand-alone 501c(7) non-profit Social Club.
- The Club was formed to promote good will and closer relations among collectors of silver strikes and to encourage the study of silver strikes and other gaming and casino related memorabilia of all kinds.
- The Club has grown to over 400 members today.

These are your five elected Officers of the Silver Strikers Club and are available for any club related business or questions that you may have. In addition, there are appointed positions within the Club performing a variety of functions. If you would like to help the club by volunteering to fill one of these appointed positions please contact any one of the club officers.

Benefits

• As a member you will receive a Newsletter twice a year and other notifications via email if you provide the Club with an email address. The Newsletter has a lot of information in it to keep you updated about the Club and its activities.



- Eligibility to enter the Club Coin Contest; vote for the Club Coin; and vote for the Strike of the Year and Hall of Fame strike(s).
- Opportunities to receive special offers from casinos to our membership.
- Attend Trade Sessions where you can buy/sell/trade silver strikes with other members.
- Purchase Club merchandise (Club coins, T-shirts and Polo shirts).



Annual Meeting

- Once a year in January the Club holds is official meeting in Las Vegas.
- During the meeting there will be reports from the Officers, any communications read, then Old Business and New Business opportunities for all members will be offered.
- Awards or Acknowledgements, if any, are presented or made.
- This is every member's time to participate in the direction the Club will move in the future.

Elections

- The Board of Directors is comprised of the five (5) Officers, President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary. Officers are elected for two (2) year terms; terms end in an even numbered year.
- Nominations are made ninety (90) days prior to the next annual club meeting in an election year.
- Thirty (30) days Prior to the election ballots are sent out, there is online voting as well on the club website.
- Special elections can be held when necessary.



Club Coin Contest

- The Club holds a Club Coin Contest yearly that is open to all members in good standing.
- Designs submitted to the chairperson will be reviewed by a panel of seven members and narrowed down to six finalists for the membership to vote on. The winning Strike is then minted and made available for purchase.

Silver Strike of the Year/Hall of Fame – SSOTY/HOF

- Members only can nominate these.
- <u>Strike of the Year</u> is for those Silver Strikes minted from December of the previous year to November of the current year.
- <u>Hall of Fame</u> is open to any strike not in the Strike of the Year category.
- There is an annual committee of four members selected by the SOTY/HOF Chairperson. They will select the candidate strikes for the membership to vote on each year.

Four Queens Events

- The Four Queens Casino has been putting on four quarterly events featuring silver strikes.
 - These events are run by the Four Queens, not the Silver Strikers Club, and are open to the public.
 - We, as a group, are part of 'The Public'. We, as a Club, should treat non-members graciously as these events are where many of our new members come from.
 - Events:
 - January This event usually has a Slot tournament package.
 - St. Patrick's Day This event has no tournament.
 - June This event usually has a Slot tournament package.
 - Halloween This event has no tournament.
- Look for event announcements on the club website under Current News and posted on Facebook or 'The Strike Point'.



Four Queens Events (continued)

- Silver Strikes released during Slot Tournament events usually include a \$300, \$40, 2 Red \$10, and 2 Blue (clad) \$10 strikes.
- To get a \$300 strike, you must trade in thirty \$10 strikes at the cashier's cage (times will be announced). Slot Tournament participants will have priority.
- You can acquire a 'rack' that is sized to hold silver strikes by asking at the Cashiers cage.
- All of the other strikes (\$40 and \$10 red/blue/clear) are won from the Silver Strike machines.
- There is also a ¼ lb. special Tournament strike if you enter the Slot Tournament. This is awarded on Sunday afternoon as a part of the Slot Tournament celebration.



Four Queens Events (continued)

- For non tournament events the released strikes are usually a \$300, \$40, Red \$10, and Blue (clad) \$10.
- Here again the \$300 Silver Strike is acquired by trading in thirty \$10 strikes.
- All of the other strikes (\$40 and \$10 red/blue/clear) are won from the Silver Strike machines.
- As always, be gracious to others and enjoy this fantastic hobby and the other folks that are kindred spirits of Silver Striking.





Finding casinos that have silver strikes

- To see a current list of Silver Strike machines and their locations look under Strikes in Play on the Club website.
- Also check Current News section regularly for the latest information on Club activities and silver strike availability.
